EEA and Norway Grants 2014 – 2021 **SLOVAKIA**

Formal compliance criteria and eligibility criteria shall be assessed by the Programme Operator (PO). If the PO identifies a shortcoming in the Grant Application, the applicant will be asked to rectify identified shortcomings and/or to supplement the missing information. The applicant shall respond to the findings (findings include shortcomings and/or missing information) of the PO within 5 working days. Within this period the applicant shall also rectify the identified shortcomings and/or supplement the missing information. Upon the request of the applicant, the PO may extend this period.

Should the applicant fail to rectify the identified shortcomings and/or supplement the missing information within the set deadline, the Grant Application shall be rejected. Applicants may appeal to the PO in case the Grant Application is rejected due to non-compliance with Formal and/or Eligibility criteria. Further information can be found in chapter 18 of the Bilateral Fund Guide.
